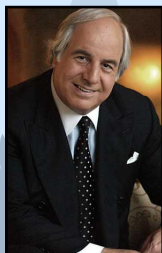

Message From The Director

Catch Me If You Can is a theatrical gem! I first saw the show in 2011 early in its run on Broadway. I was a big fan of the 2002 film starting Tom Hank and Leonardo DiCaprio and so when I heard that Marc Shaiman and Scott Whitman were writing the score for a Broadway musical version with a book by Terrence McNally, I couldn't wait to see it. Marc and Scott's first Broadway show was the mega-hit, *Hairspray* (which I was lucky to direct at MTW). The opening bars of the *Catch Me* score were electric and I was immediately transported to the 1960's and all of those great variety shows that my parents and grandparents watched, from "Mitch Miller" and "The Dean Martin Show" to "Hullabaloo" and "Shindig"! The device for telling the show is a director's and choreographer's dream; big flashy numbers that span many musical genres with lush orchestrations. And the real life story is truly mesmerizing in that a 16 year old was able to invent and reinvent himself in the unlikeliness of ways. It's a story about broken families and incredible adventure and eventual love and redemption. I couldn't ask for better partners in putting this show together. Choreographer Peggy Hickey is inventive and an amazing collaborator and this show is a perfect vehicle for her work. Conductor/musical director Dennis Castellano is exactly the right musician to drive the musical engine of this musical. Thank you, Paul, for putting *Catch Me* in your season. And thank you, all of you, for taking a chance on a show you don't know. Fasten your seatbelt and enjoy the ride!

Frank Abagnale Jr. Today

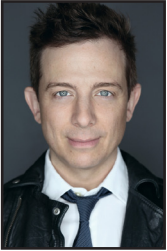


Frank William Abagnale, Jr. is known for his history as a former trickster, check forger, and impostor between the ages of 15 and 21. Today, he is one of the world's leading authorities on secure documents, fraud and embezzlement. He has been associated with the FBI for more than 35 years. Abagnale has been married for over 34 years, is the father of three sons and has three grandchildren. He is the author of several books on crime, including "Can Me If You Can", and is a world-renowned public speaker who has keynoted more than 3,000 events in over 30 years on the event circuit. He also runs Abagnale & Associates, a financial fraud consultancy company. Steven Spielberg said it best: "I didn't immortalize Frank Abagnale on film because of what he did 40 years ago as a teenager. I chose to immortalize him on film because of what he's done for his country for more than 30 years."

PAUL GARMAN

(EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR /PRODUCER) began with MTW in 1963 when the company was known as Whittier Civic Light Opera. He has served as producer for MTW since the mid-1970s. Prior to that he served seven years as the company's President. Of the 195 MTW major productions, Paul has been involved with all but 16, producing 179 of them. Under his leadership, MTW has grown from an amateur community organization to a nationally respected regional theatre group, entertaining over 60,000 patrons annually and garnering critical acclaim and numerous awards. In 2007 the organization was presented with the L.A. Drama Critics' Circle Award for Sustained Excellence in theatre and has won numerous L.A. Stage Ovation awards over the years including Best Musical for 2012. Paul received the Arts Community Leadership award from the Arts Council for LB in 2002 and Arts Education Hero of the Year Award from the Carpenter Performing Arts Center in 2008. He has been inducted into the La Serna High School Hall of Fame and was honored as Distinguished Alumni of Whittier by the Whittier Historical Society. His key passion remains the cultivation of new works for the musical stage and introducing young audiences to musical theatre.

TERRENCE McNALLY (BOOK)

was awarded the Dramatists Guild Lifetime Achievement Award in 2011. He is the winner of Tony Awards for his plays *Love! Valour! He and co-lyricist Scott Wittman have written the songs for Disney's "Mary Poppins Returns" (Golden Globe & Oscar nominations). Their West End/Broadway musical *Charlie & The Chocolate Factory* is touring North America. Mr. Shaiman has been nominated for two Tony Awards (winning one for co-writing the score to *Hairspray* with co-lyricist and exec. producer Scott Wittman), four Grammy Awards, (winning one for The Original Cast Recording of *Hairspray*), eleven Emmy Awards (winning one for his work on Billy Crystal's Academy Award hosting) and five Oscar nominations (for "Sleepless In Seattle", "Patch Adams", "The First Wives Club", "The American President" and "South Park-Bigger, Longer & Uncut"). Mr. Shaiman's other film work includes "Beaches", "When Harry Met Sally", "City Slickers", "The Addams Family", "A Few Good Men", "Sister Act" (1 & 2), "Hocus Pocus", "The Bucket List" and "Parental Guidance", to name a few.

SCOTT WITTMAN (LYRICS) co-wrote the lyrics for the Olivier Award winning musical *Hairspray*, for which the pair received Tony and Grammy Awards. EDUCATION & OUTREACH

Student Matinee Performances: Each of our five Mainstage productions include weekday matinee performances for local schools designed to introduce children to live musical theatre. This program is offered at little or no cost to schools. We believe that exposure to live theatre is a crucial element for a well-rounded education. This year, approximately 6,000 area students from 30 schools participated in this program.



Classroom Visits: Prior to each student matinee performance, MTW actors and educational staff visit attending schools for an invigorating workshop engaging students and teachers alike. This year we were happy to provide 72 workshops to 20 area schools. During this workshop students learn about the upcoming production and other specific elements of live theatre.

Traveling Theatre Productions: During the summer of 2018, MTW hired high school performers to tour a 45-minute version of *You're a Good Man Charlie Brown* to 24 different libraries and parks in partnership with Long Beach Parks and Recreation. MTW provided these performances for free to the young audiences and will be touring *Pioneers of Flight* to area schools this spring.

Summer Youth Conservatory: Our Summer Youth Conservatory is a weekday program that includes intensive study of acting, singing and dancing and culminates in a performance at the conclusion of a three-week camp. Students are able to experience rehearsal and studio training prior to showcasing their work. A fully produced live performance gives students an opportunity to experience being part of a musical production from start to finish.



Youth Ambassador Council: An application-based program designed to cultivate the next generation of theatrical artists, patrons and innovators. These select students have the opportunity to interact and learn from industry professionals. While a member of the council, students collaborate on creative projects and theatrical opportunities.



High School Scholarships: Each year, the MTW Footlighters award scholarships to local high school students. Since the program's inception, over \$85,000 in scholarships have been awarded to deserving students. Many of our previous winners have attended premiere musical theatre programs across the country. This year we had 62 applicants from 22-area schools audition for the awards. 12 students were each awarded a \$1,000 Scholarship in order to pursue advanced training in the field.

Residency: In 2018, MTW provided a director, choreographer, and scenic designer to assist with Wilson High School's production of *Disney's Aladdin*. This spring, MTW will partner again with Wilson and also with Orange County School of the Arts for their production of *Evita*.

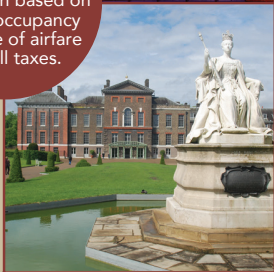
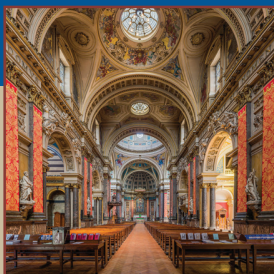
